For the protection of our Holy Mother Church from scandal, Lord, shine your light on any darkness within the Church – that it may be exposed and eradicated. We pray to the Lord. (R) **Lord, hear our prayer.**

For all those who have turned from God and embraced evil, grant them revelation, conversion, and forgiveness. We pray to the Lord. (R) **Lord, hear our prayer.**

For the guidance and protection of all youth, we pray to the Lord. (R) **Lord, hear our prayer.**

For these and any other intentions we hold in our hearts, we pray to the Lord. (R) **Lord, hear our prayer.**

### **The Rosary:**

#### **Apostle's Creed**

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord, who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. **I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.**

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. **Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.**

- Say the "Glory Be".

#### **Glory Be**

(please bow your head until the words "Holy Spirit" are spoken)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. *As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.*

Combined Prayers & Meditation (The Sorrowful Mysteries are traditionally prayed on Tuesdays and Fridays)
