

Raul H. Castro Institute Symposium celebrated (with Governor Janet Napolitano announcing) February 16th as **Raul H. Castro Institute Day**. This Proclamation included statistics stating **“Latinos represent the fastest growing minority group in the nation ... at this growth rate, Latinos will soon become the largest ethnic population group in the state.”** Is this why the institute is so interested in working with Planned Parenthood? 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To mark the founding of the Raul H. Castro Institute, **Governor Janet Napolitano proclaimed February 16, 2006 as Raul H. Castro Day.** The official proclamation includes the following statistics:

Latinos represent the fastest growing minority group in the nation. In 2002, there were 37.4 million Latinos in the U.S., representing 13.3 percent of the total population, with approximately 1.3 million Latinos in Arizona, representing over 25 percent of the state population. Arizona's Latino population increased by almost 90 percent between 1990 and 2000. **At this growth rate, Latinos will soon become the largest ethnic population group in the state.**
